In addition to tutoring, this GTAs assist with administrative tasks including planning workshops, leading class visits, creating resources, and more!



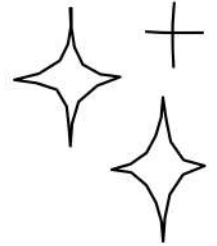
